3. Each Nomination should be signed by the Sponsor.
4. Nominations which are incomplete in respect of any of the details may be declared invalid.
5. A List of research papers (giving the name of all the authors, title of the paper and reference regarding publications e.g. name of journal, volume, page no. and year) should accompany the Nomination papers. The most important of the papers should be specially indicated with a circle on the numbers in the List.
6. Nominations should be accompanied by copies of the significant research papers and technical reports in the area of work.
7. There should be a WRITE - UP covering :-
 - a) Significant contributions, to Science and Technology by the nominee during recent years (in about 500 words).
 - b) Measurable impact of the work of the nominee on national development in the area.
 - c) CITATION covering the most important contribution of the nominee (in 100 words).
 - d) Places where R & D work has been utilized
(With photographs and other documented evidence.)
 - e) List of Technical and other reports of special relevance to the Foundation, which will help in assessing the contribution.
 - f) Details of patents taken, if any.
 - g) Names and addresses of three experts in the area (preferably in India) as possible referees.
